## **In The Field – Professional Training for CSBs and Embodied Counsellors**

### **Prerequisite**

Certificate in Sexological Bodywork (CSB) or Introductory Certificate in Embodied Counselling (ICEC)

### **Purpose**

This experiential training offers CSBs and ICECs the opportunity to expand their skills and knowledge set. Participants engage in nearly a month of daily embodied practices, and share about their experience in a private online group. There are then 3 days of professional development training at Yanada, followed by 6 days of practice with real clients, along with input, feedback and mentoring on your client work and group facilitation skills. You will receive in-depth professional supervision from Uma, Betty and Deej, all in a stunning retreat centre in the Hawkesbury River region of NSW. We keep the group small in order to give you personal attention.

## Program Components

### Embodied Practice and Discussion

Enhance and fine tune your personal practice with 4 weeks of guidance, sharing and discussion in a community of peers.

### Professional Development Training

3 days in-depth experience and practice in the Wheel of Consent with Betty, client-led sessions with Uma and somatic education and embodied counselling with Deej.

### In The Field Clinic Week Intensive

Facilitated by Uma, Betty and Deej

Participants will:

- develop their somatic sex education skills through the process of working with real clients on authentic learning objectives, and having immediate access to input from peers and facilitators before and after sessions.
- develop their coaching and mentoring skills in ongoing small group processes, and have the opportunity to reflect on their work to improve practice.
- have essential input, experience, and feedback in facilitating groups.
- receive regular supervision in small groups and one-on-one from the facilitators
- engage in regular embodiment classes, erotic rituals and meditations, and spend a wonderful week connecting with their peers and building networks and community.

### How it works

After the 4 weeks of practice, we meet at a beautiful residential retreat centre for 3 days of professional development (as described above). Then real clients arrive for the Growing in Embodiment Retreat. You will be giving these clients daily one-on-one sessions and teaching group classes, with the support and mentoring of Deej, Betty and Uma.

## Certification

CSBs who complete the program to the satisfaction of the facilitators will receive the Certificate in Applied Practice of Somatic Sex Education from ISS.

ICECs who complete the program to the satisfaction of the facilitators will receive the Certificate in Applied Practice of Embodied Counselling from ISS.

## Residential

The residential program is held at Yanada Retreat, in the beautiful Hawkesbury River region of New South Wales, Australia. Food and accommodation is provided and included in the price.



## Price

The early bird price is \$3,500 (including GST) for payments before December 6, 2019. For payments from December 7, 2020, the price is \$3,900 (including GST). A non-refundable deposit of \$550 is required to secure your place on the training.

The price includes food and accommodation at Yanada from April 3 to April 12 2020, as well as all tuition and supervision with Betty, Uma and Deej.

All payments must be made before February 28, 2020.

## Refund Policy

If you withdraw from the training before March 2, 2020, any money will be returned less the \$550 deposit. If you withdraw from the training on or after March 3, 2020 there is no refund.
